

# Southern Vermont



Visitors to the smallest region of the state will find one of the largest choices of activities throughout a very diverse landscape.

The Connecticut River on the eastern border of the region offers many opportunities for swimming, boating or fishing. The Battenkill River on the western side of the state is world renowned for its fly-fishing. The West River, which flows southeast through the center of the region, is widely cherished for its white-water rafting.

The region also features a number of man-made reservoirs for boating and fishing. Route 100 travels up the center of the region, offering unsurpassed views that visually stun at their peak during the fall foliage season (mid-October). Mount Snow, Stratton Mountain, and Bromley Mountain offer visitors the chance to hike or mountain bike and enjoy stunning views of the surrounding Green Mountains, the Adirondacks to the west and the Berkshires to the south. Mount Equinox in the west offers a toll road to the summit.

The region hosts a variety of private and state campgrounds offering campers their choice of camping experiences from the very rustic “back country hike-in-hike out” to the full service RV Parks.

Throughout the quiet villages, old-time country stores and outdoor flea markets provide both bygone, quirky antiques and today’s playthings. Attend a performance at a summer playhouse, or tour museums and historic sites such as the Bennington Monument. Manchester is a town filled with outlet stores, sure to please any dedicated shopper. Golfing enthusiasts will not have to look far to find a golf course that fits them to a ‘tee’. Bikers can travel the many back roads to quietly enjoy the countryside or use the ski trails at the several ski areas to challenge their mountain-biking skills. The Long and Appalachian trails offer the hiker/camper the opportunity to enjoy the mountain tops of southern Vermont, and the chance to continue their backpacking journey up through the State all the way into Canada.


